What is Accelerated Reader? Accelerated Reader (AR) is a web-based program used at school for grades 1st-8th. When a student finishes a book, he or she can then take an AR test on it and earn points.

The longer the book, the more points it will be. (Gone With the Wind is 71 points. Fly Guy and the Frankenfly is ½ of a point.)

How do I know if a book is in the Accelerated Reader program? You can look it up on www.arbookfind.com. Please note that not every book in our library has an AR test.

How can I check my child's progress in AR? I can create a username for you after you follow these steps:

- Go to http://Hosted224.renlearn.com/210853
- Click "I'm a Parent" and then "Request Parent/Guardian Access" towards the bottom of the screen
- Put in your necessary information

What now? A request will be sent to me, and I will send you an email with your new username and password!

PLEASE REMEMBER. Encourage your children to read books that interest and excite them! © AR points can be fun to gain, but the most important thing to me is that our students find books they enjoy reading!
