Sunday afternoon is for parents only, to allow you an opportunity to hear from your student’s teacher and receive important information about Sacred Heart School! We look forward to seeing you Sunday!

**REQUIRED FORMS DUE THURSDAY, AUGUST 18.** Three important forms are due back at school by Thursday, August 18, the Parent-Student handbook form, the Home & School agreement form, and the Health/Emergency/Student Information form. The Health/Emergency/Student information form will be in packets at the Back-to-School afternoon on Sunday, August 14. Students returning all three signed forms by Thursday, August 14, will receive free dress on Friday, August 26. Information on acceptable dress for that Friday will be in next week’s newsletter.

**SACRED HEART OF JESUS SCHOOL IS NOW A CASHLESS CAMPUS.** Sacred Heart of Jesus School is no longer accepting cash. Accepted payment types are personal checks, cashier’s checks, and money orders. Credit card payments are acceptable through RenWeb. We are in the process of adding club fees, field trip fees, and other fees to the RenWeb system. **SCHOOL LITURGY.** Our weekly school liturgy will be Wednesday, August 10, 8 a.m. Mass leaders will be students in 8th grade. Parents, you are invited to attend this and all school liturgies. **PRE-K/K AND MASS ATTENDANCE.** Pre-K and kindergarten students do not attend Mass at this time. They will begin attending in late September or early October. Parents of students in these grades will be notified by teachers and through *The Tuesday Newsletter* of their start date. Pre-K and kindergarten students are not required to wear dress uniforms on Wednesday until they attend Mass.

**SCOUT ROUND-UP.** Scout leaders will be in the gym on Tuesday, August 16, 2:15 p.m. to talk with students about scouting. Boys in first through fifth grade and girls in kindergarten through fourth grade will be invited to learn more about scouts.

**SACRED HEART OF JESUS ST. VINCENT DE PAUL FOOD PANTRY.** Sacred Heart of Jesus St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry serves people in need who live within the geographical boundaries of Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish. Collection for the food pantry is made each week during our school liturgy. Students, faculty, and staff donate non-perishable food items and are a major source of donations for the pantry. Money collections are also taken and used to further the mission of this ministry. Most weeks we’ll also post an update of needs in the pantry that may make it easy for your student to select an item to bring. With school being out, the pantry is extremely low on a number of items, including peanut butter, jelly, tuna, canned meats, canned milk, pasta sauce, canned fruit, soups, pork and beans, and mac and cheese. **FALL SPORTS.** We kick off the school year running in terms of sports for students of all ages! Swimming, cross country, football and girls basketball are underway!

**SWIMMING.** Another season of middle school swimming is upon us! Students in fifth through eighth grades are eligible for our swim team! Our swim team is coached by Sacred Heart dad Adam Werth. **CROSS COUNTRY.** Cross country practice is underway! It's not too late to sign up and join our runners! Cross country is open to students in fifth through eighth grades. Cross country practices this week will be Tuesday and Thursday, August 9 and 11, 5:30 p.m. City Park. The regular practice schedule begins next week: Monday through Thursday, 5:30 until 6:30 p.m., City Park. The team will also practice on the following Saturdays at 8 a.m. at Highland Road Park: August 13, August 20, August 27. Participation fee is \$65 per athlete and is due to athletic director Cornell Christophe by August 22. Each athlete must have a current physical on file and that is also due to Coach Cornell by August 28th. A sign-up sheet is located on the junior high bulletin board (second floor of the Main Building).
