Because a butterfly undergoes a metamorphosis from lowly caterpillar to beautiful adult butterfly, it is a symbol of Christ rising from the dead in his glorified body.

The flower motifs are taken from stone carvings on the exterior of Sacred Heart church, designed by the building's architect, Albert Bendernagel.





Sacred Heart of Jesus Church's Beautiful Paschal Candle.



The Paschal candle represents Jesus Christ, the Light of the World. Made of pure beeswax, it represent the sinless Christ who incarnated in the womb of His Mother. The wick signifies His humanity; the flame, His divinity. At the Easter Vigil, a new fire is kindled to light the candle, symbolizing our new life in Christ

Inscribed in the candle is a cross, the first and last letters of the Greek alphabet (Alpha and Omega-the beginning and the end) and the current year. There are five grains of incense inserted into it in the form of a cross, recalling the aromatic spices used to anoint Our Lord's Body and the five wounds in His hands, feet, and side.

As we gaze upon our Paschal Candle, it reminds us of the many gifts which we receive from our Catholic faith. We are also reminded of the creativity of the artist, our own Archivist, Mary Lee Eggart.

Her talent is outstanding, matched by her generosity, her joyful expression of her faith and her love of Sacred Heart.

Thank you Mary Lee for the beauty that you add to Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish.




