



COMING SOON!

SACRED HEART SCHOOL PRAYER ROOM



Joseph Hall on the Sacred Heart School campus was constructed in 1955 as a convent for the Sisters of St. Joseph staffing the school. The building, designed by Baton Rouge architect J. Roy Haase, included a chapel for the use of the nuns. The design of the sanctuary and altar was conceived by Louis J. Tango of New Orleans.

When the sisters moved out of the convent in 1985, the building was turned over to the school and the chapel was used by the parish for daily Mass. In the early 1990s, the chapel altar, pews, and other furnishings were moved to the church sacristy to create a daily Mass chapel there. The convent chapel became the art room for the school.

In 2022, it was decided that the chapel should return to its intended use as a sacred space. The room will be used for personal prayer for the faculty and class prayer for the students. In the "School Prayer Room" students will be taught how to recite the Mysteries of the Rosary, pray the Stations of the Cross, meditate on Sacred Scriptures through Lectio Divina, contemplate the Face of Christ in Adoration, and sing to the Lord with Gospel Hymns, Traditional Chants and Praise, and Worship.




All the renovations are being donated for free to our School by the Saint Louis IX Art Society. Sacred Heart parishioner and artisan Andrew Coleman is creating a Sacred Heart reliquary that will contain a large number of relics. Artist Blair Barlow will create several original paintings of Jesus and Mary to grace the walls of the room. The original convent altar will be returned and pews added.

The School Art Class Room will be moved to the main building. This will provide more space, light, seating, and supplies for our students to mature in their creativity and craftsmanship.



SPOTLIGHT ON ST. ROMUALD

St. Romuald | June 19



St. Romuald was born at Ravenna about the year 956. In spite of an infinite desire for virtue and sanctity, his early life was wasted in the service of the world and its pleasures. Then one day, obliged by his father, Sergius, to be present at a duel fought by him, he beheld him slay his adversary. The crime made such an impression upon him that he determined to expiate it for forty days, as though it were entirely his own. For this purpose he retired to a Benedictine monastery of St. Apollinare, near Ravenna, where he became Abbot. After founding several monasteries, he laid the foundations of the austere Order of Camaldoli in Tuscany. Like all the saints, he fought a lifelong battle against the assaults of devils and men. In the beginning of his spiritual life he was strongly assailed by numerous temptations, which he conquered by vigilance and prayer. More than one attempt was made on his life, but Divine Providence enabled him to escape from the danger. Like many servants of God, he also became the victim of calumny, which he bore in patience and silence. In

his old age, he increased his austerities instead of diminishing them. After a long life of merit, he died in the monastery of Castro, which he founded in Marquisate of Ancona. His death occurred on June 19, about the year 1027. His feast day is June 19th.




