### SPOTLIGHT ON ST. CAMILLUS DE LELLIS



### ST. CAMILLUS DE LELLIS | July 18

Camillus grew up with an excessive love for gambling. At 17, he became ill and entered the San Giacomo Hospital for Incurables as both patient and servant, but was dismissed for fighting. By the age of 24 Camillus had gambled away everything he possessed. Desperate, he went to work at a Capuchin friary. There he began a conversion that changed his life. He tried his vocation in the Capuchin novitiate twice, but was dismissed because of his health. Uncertain what to do, but desiring to serve God he returned to the San Giacomo Hospital where he eventually became superintendent. Camillus devoted the rest of his life to the care of the sick. With the advice of his friend St. Philip Neri, he was ordained a priest at the age of 34. Charity was his first concern, but Camillus insisted on cleanliness and the technical competence of those who served the sick under his care
