## From the Archives

### Monsignor Blasco's Chalice Returns Home to Sacred Heart!

Dominic Blasco was born in Ganci, Sicily on December 24, 1894 and grew up in Cefalu. He entered the Diocesan Seminary of Cefalu in 1909 at the age of 15. Having a desire to serve in the New World, he offered his services to the archdiocese of New Orleans, arriving in 1914 to continue his studies at St. Joseph's Preparatory Seminary in St. Benedict. He completed his course work in philosophy and theology, in addition to other studies, at Kenrick Major Seminary in St. Louis. On June 12, 1921, he was ordained a priest at Kenrick by Archbishop (later Cardinal) John Glennon. Later that year, Archbishop Shaw of New Orleans assigned Father Blasco to assist Monsignor Gassler at St. Joseph's Church in Baton Rouge. In 1924 he was given the responsibility of conducting catechetical work for the newly formed Sacred Heart mission in addition to his other parish duties.

When the mission was officially established as Sacred Heart Parish in 1928, Father Blasco was appointed as its first pastor. The effectiveness of both his spiritual and fiscal leadership was demonstrated by the phenomenal growth of the Sacred Heart family and its parish plant. After years of planning and fund-raising, Father Blasco realized his dream of a beautiful church building for the parish when the new Sacred Heart Church was dedicated in April 1942. In May 1947, Pope Pius XII elevated the pastor to the rank of Domestic Prelate with the title of Right Reverend Monsignor. Monsignor Blasco's life and interests, his zeal and energy, were all dedicated to his flock at Sacred Heart. While preparing to administer the Last Rites to a parishioner on March 11, 1948, the pastor was stricken with a fatal heart attack. His body lay in state in the church he had built until the Pontifical Requiem Mass on March 15, officiated by Archbishop Joseph Francis Rummell. Monsignor Blasco took over a tiny mission and left it a flourishing parish with a beautiful church and a thriving school. Seventy-five years after his death, we continue to be blessed by the fruits of his labor.

Upon Monsignor Blasco's death in 1948, his ordination Chalice was preserved by his brother, Santo Blasco and wife Rose Graphia Blasco. The beautifully ornate vessel features the 14 stations of the cross encircling the cup and base. In later years, it was cared for by Monsignor Blasco's niece, Mattia Blasco Didier. The Blasco family is honored to deliver the Chalice back to Sacred Heart, its church home. The Chalice is being donated by Mattia's children, great nieces and nephew of Monsignor Blasco: Cindy Malone Hunt, Elizabeth Malone Troia, and Bernard Malone III, and Mattia's sisters: Catherine Blasco Gueho and Mary Blasco Nola. According to the wishes of the surviving members of the Blasco family, the Chalice will remain at Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church.

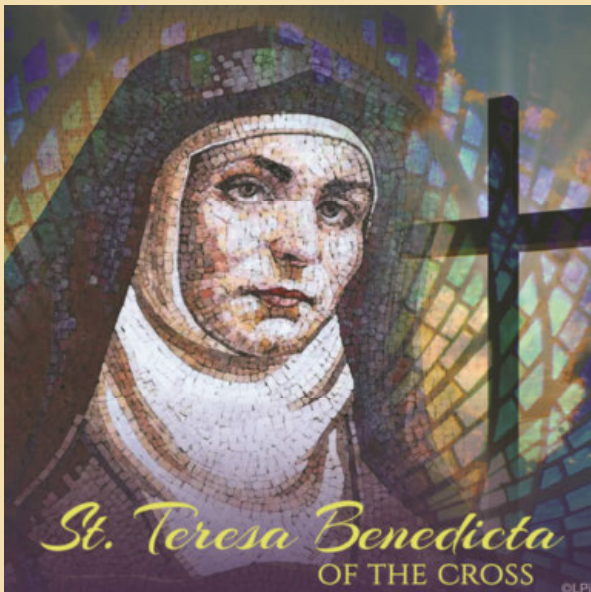

**SPOTLIGHT ON ST. TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS**



**ST. TERESA BENEDICTA OF THE CROSS | August 9**

Edith Stein, born Jewish, was an outstanding philosopher and a committed atheist. While staying with friends she read the autobiography of Teresa of Avila and began a spiritual journey that led to her baptism in 1922. Twelve years later she imitated Saint Teresa by becoming a Carmelite, taking the name Teresa Benedicta of the Cross. Edith came to Carmel after years of teaching philosophy in Germany. She lost her university position when the Nazis drove the Jews from public offices. She lived for four years in the Cologne Carmel, but moved to a monastery in Holland in 1938. The Nazis occupied that country in 1940. In retaliation for a letter read by the Dutch bishops denouncing them, the Nazis arrested all Dutch Jews who had become Christians. Teresa Benedicta died at Auschwitz on August 9, 1942.
