
Sunday December 17, 2023 following 11:00 a.m. Mass

D.A.R.E. is the sheriff's office initiative led by a law enforcement officer that teaches a series of classroom lessons to 5th-grade students on how to resist peer pressure and live productive drug and violence-free lives using the D.A.R.E. decisionmaking model. The D.A.R.E. decision-making model is the framework that can help make wellinformed decisions by providing a structured approach. All students were presented with graduation certificates, a t-shirt, and a goodie bag.

Winning the D.A.R.E essay contest were students Peyton Landry (3rd place), Ethan Coates(2nd place), and Brooklyn Nelson (1st place). Students read their essays out loud and were presented with D.A.R.E. essay winner certificates. Kyle Daniels was presented with the Special Service Award and received \$20!
