

From the Archives

Sacred Heart's Creche

Sacred Heart's nativity statues made their debut in 1942, the first Christmas that the parish celebrated in their beautiful new church building. Parish legend says that the statues were created in Italy, but no records have been found to verify their origin.

In the January 10, 1943 Parish Messenger, pastor Msgr. Dominic Blasco wrote: "It seems that our new crib has excited the admiration of all those who have seen it. In fact, it is a very artistic crib. We are still true to our policy; nothing should be too beautiful or too costly for the home of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, either interiorly or the grounds that surround it. Please do not accuse your Pastor of extravagance. It is true, he has a very expensive taste, but he certainly knows how to make the old dollar go far. It must not be forgotten that our



Parish has many friends, far and near, and all take great pride in the new church. The new crib, which cost \$380.00, plus transportation, has not been paid for but the Infant Jesus will touch the heart of someone - we feel confident that the money will be forthcoming. Let's trust in Divine Providence. Why be discouraged?"

Did you know....

- •The statues are made of plaster and are about 3/4 life size.
- •They have undergone major restoration 3 times: in the late 1950s, the early 1980s and 2005.
- 2007
- •The 3 shepherds are named for 3 of Sacred Heart's early pastors: Dominic (Blasco), Paul (Gauci) and Jerome (Dugas).
- •A cat was added to the crib in the mid 1980s in accordance with an old Italian legend about the cat who witnessed the first Christmas. For the first several years, only children seemed to notice the presence of the cat in Sacred Heart's crib.
 - •There is a sheep dog in the crib.
- •In 2007 a new baby Jesus statue was generously donated by parishioner Susie Hotard and the Knights of Columbus. The new statue, crafted in Florence, Italy, is a perfect match to the original except that it is made of wood. This makes it a much lighter burden for the child chosen to carry it in the Christmas Vigil procession. It is also smaller and in better proportion with the other statues.

If you have any information or stories about the Sacred Heart nativity statues, please share them with the archives committee. We are especially interested in photographs of the statues from the 1940s,50s or 60s. Any materials can be brought to the parish office in the rectory. Photographs will be returned if requested.
