

From the Archives



The Altar of Repose

On Holy Thursday, during the Mass of the Lord's Supper, sufficient hosts are consecrated for the faithful to receive Communion both at that Mass and the next day, Good Friday, when Mass is not celebrated. The hosts intended for the Good Friday service are not placed in the tabernacle, but are left on the altar, while the priest says the post communion prayer. The sacrament is then carried in solemn procession to a place of reservation, called the Altar of Repose. At Sacred Heart this has always been the altar dedicated to the Blessed Virgin in the eastern arm of the transept. The priest covers his hands with the humeral veil so that they do not touch the vessel containing the hosts, as a mark of respect for the sacred vessel and as an indication that Jesus is present in the Eucharist.





The procession is led by a cross-bearer accompanied by servers with lighted candles and a thurible (incense burner) immediately precedes the priest. At the end of the Holy Thursday service all altars, except the one used as the Altar of Repose, are stripped. The Blessed Sacrament remains in the temporary place until the Holy Communion part of the Good Friday liturgical service.

Roman Catholic piety has made Holy Thursday a day of exceptional devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, and the place where the Sacrament is reserved is a focal point for the love and aspirations of the faithful. Eucharistic adoration is encouraged at the place of reservation.


