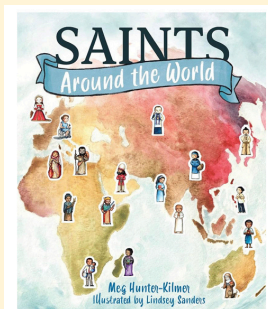


Family Conversation
